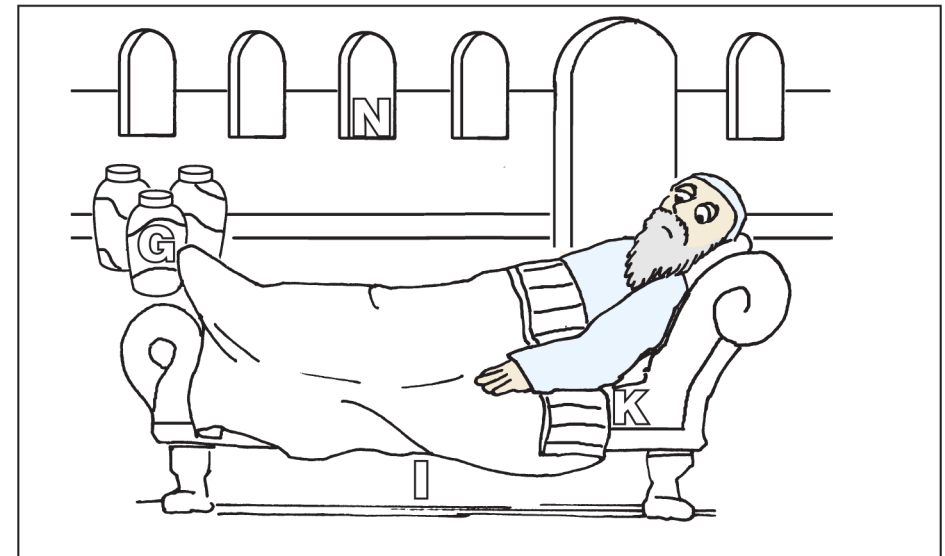

Circle the people playing musical instruments.

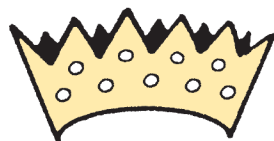
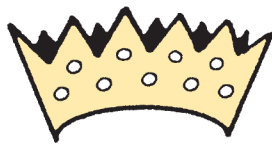
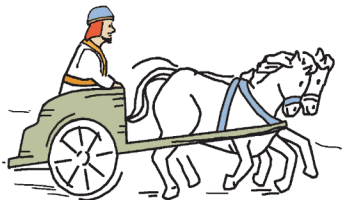
